

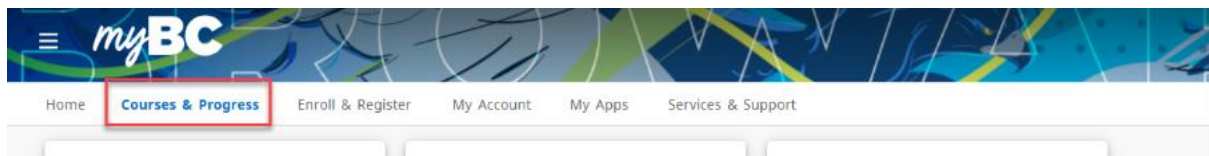
How to Review Your Degree Audit in the New myBC

Your Degree Audit is your official academic progress report. It shows exactly where you stand with your degree, including completed courses, courses in progress, and requirements you still need to finish. Reviewing your degree audit before registration helps ensure you choose the right classes and stay on track to graduate.

Step-by-Step Guide: How to Review Your Degree Audit

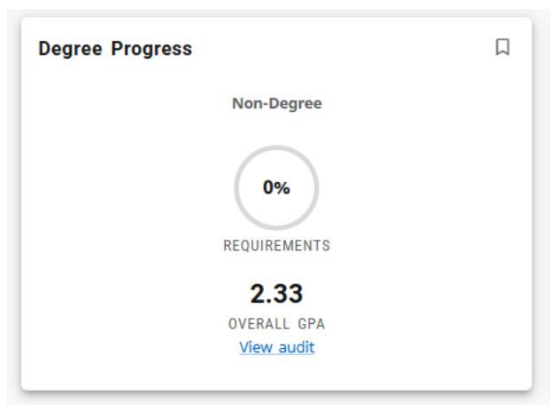
Step 1: Login to myBC

- Log in to the **new myBC**.
- From the new myBC Dashboard, click on the **Courses & Progress** section.



Step 2: Open the Degree Progress Card

- Find the **Degree Progress** card.



- The **Degree Audit** will load as a sperate page.

- These edits were **approved by your advisor** and are already cleared.
- No further action is needed unless your advisor instructs you otherwise.

Helpful Tips

- Completed courses are checked off; unchecked courses are what you still need to complete.
- Make it a habit to review your **Degree Audit before every registration period** as it's the easiest way to confirm you're taking the right classes and progressing toward graduation.
